
Can you sew?

Future use of Broadholes Lane Play area Consultation WE WANT YOUR VIEWS!

For a few years LSWA PC has been looking at ways to improve the use of Broadholes Lane Play area.

The Parish Council carry out significant work in the area at the start of each season to ensure it is safe for opening in April. This is in addition to the regular grounds maintenance plus the costs to make any repairs following vandalism. Due to the lack of use and concerns about appropriate use it is time to investigate if the area can be beneficial to the community in a different manner.

The Parish Council has been tasked with considering other ways to use the area and have already consulted with neighbours in the immediate vicinity of the area to obtain their views.

We have discussed the change of use to community allotments or an outdoor gym. Both of these options have been put forward for more consideration, due to the enclosed nature of the

space, a facility aimed at adults would be beneficial and more appropriate

To be clear, there have not been any decisions made to date and the Council is open to other suggestions; If you have another view for another facility then please get in touch.

The outcome from the first consultation was that allotments would be the preferred community benefit and the parish council are currently seeking The Allotments advice from Association whether this is possible, before a decision is made, a feasibility study needs to be conducted on the soil. We hope to be able to make a final decision at the parish council meeting on 3rd March 2022. Any decision will subject to funding for which we are seeking accessible grants

Following the decision all residents will be invited to an open meeting at the village hall to view plans and; should the decision be to create allotments; meet representatives of the Allotments Association for advice on having your own plot. More details on this to follow.
