Volunteers required!!! Can you spare some time to help with the newly formed Community Speed Watch Group?

Would you like to be a volunteer trained by Staffordshire Police? The training will last for about 2 hours, is free and will cover all elements of Community Speed Watch.

Volunteers dictate when they will go out, for how long and at which of their chosen locations they will stand. Schemes can only operate in daylight hours and cannot be operational in the rain or snow.

New play Equipment at Primrose Play Area

After much consideration, the Parish Council have placed an order for some new equipment to be installed. This will replace the wooden equipment that was removed sometime ago. Playdale Playgrounds Ltd will be installing the equipment in early Spring 2018. A date has not been confirmed at this point.

A trim trail, gravity rider and a unit with a slide called 'Hong Kong' are the exciting new additions. All of the equipment is aimed at toddlers from 18 months plus.
