The best time to plant trees is from October to March. British oak trees support an estimated 2,300 species, an incredible variety of wildlife. A mature tree can absorb up to 150kg of CO2 a year. UK green spaces remove up to 1.3 billion kg of air pollutants each year. Well-placed trees can help cool the air between 2 and 8 degrees in urban communities
