Camp Bestival 2023

Camp Bestival is taking place between Thursday 17th and Monday 21st August 2023 at Weston Park.

The event is an award-winning family festival featuring family fun activities; children's shows; theatrical entertainment and live musical performances, together with a full range of gourmet and street food concession stalls and bar and refreshment facilities. Half of those attending will be children. Campsite facilities are provided on site for families, and various outdoor activities will take place.

No major traffic disruption is expected over the weekend with any increased traffic likely to be during arrivals over Thursday and Friday and departures on Monday 21st August. The only road closure in effect during the event will be Mill Lane.

Several improvements have been made this year to reduce disturbance to local residents. This includes closing down each of the stages an hour earlier, and a completely new site layout to move the stages further into Weston Park with different orientations.

There is one main music stage which is scheduled to close by 11pm. Subsidiary stages will finish by midnight.

There will be a small low noise fireworks display lasting around 5 minutes on Sunday 20th August at approximately 22.25. The Red Devils parachute team will also display at approximately 10.15 on Saturday morning for 30 minutes and are scheduled to do a night display at 22.30 on Sunday. (This will include flares.)

Litter picking teams will be in place each day to clean surrounding roads in the area on a regular basis.
